Use a singular noun with I / He / She / It / You (1 person):

I am (I'm) He is (He's) She is (She's) It is (It's) You are (You're)

a student a doctor a teacher a farmer a drummer a nurse

a boy a girl a dog

a man

a woman a singer

my friend my mother my father

my pet





Use a plural noun with They / We / You (2+ people):

They are (They're) You are (You're) We are (We're)

students teachers doctors boys girls

dogs brothers sisters friends cats
