## Past Tense (1)

We use the **Past Tense** to talk about things that happened **before now.** 

Many verbs add **-ed** to make the **Past Tense** (these are called the "Regular Verbs"):

- I played tennis yesterday.
- I finished my homework last night.

"-ed" can have 3 different sounds: "t," "d," or "ed."

" <del>t"</del>	"d"	"d"	"ed"
asked	cleaned	played	needed
looked	learned	used	started
finished	listened	studied	counted
talked	changed	closed	wanted
worked	turned on	tried	ended
watched	turned off	opened
