With Count Nouns, you can use the words "There are":

**There are** a few cars

**There are** many houses

**There are** some birds

**There are** a lot of shoes

**There are** a few cups

**There are** some people

With Noncount Nouns, you can use the words "There is":

**There is** a little time

**There is** a lot of corn

**There is** some milk

**There is** some cake

**There is** much love

**There is** a lot of money
