

3.1 Count Nouns & Noncount Nouns

In English, you can **count** some nouns:

(When you have more than one of these "count nouns", use the plural form of the noun.)

1 car → 3 cars
 1 house → 8 houses
 1 boy → 6 boys
 1 computer → 20 computers

1 shirt → 2 shirts
 1 cup → 5 cups
 1 hand → 2 hands
 1 pen → 10 pens

But you **cannot count** some nouns:

water air love
 hair juice milk
 money rice food
 corn sand soup
