With **count nouns**, you can use **"a few"**:

car → a few cars
house → a few houses
bird → a few birds

shoe → a few shoes
cup → a few cups
hand → a few hands



With **noncount nouns**, you can use **"a little"**:

water → a little water
sand → a little sand
money → a little money

time → a little time
soup → a little soup
snow → a little snow
