## With count nouns, you can use "a few":

shoe  $\longrightarrow$  a few shoes cup  $\longrightarrow$  a few cups hand  $\longrightarrow$  a few hands

## With noncount nouns, you can use "a little":

water  $\longrightarrow$  a little water sand  $\longrightarrow$  a little sand money  $\longrightarrow$  a little money

time a little time soup a little soup snow a little snow
