

5.1 Introduction to Embedded Questions

Embedded questions are questions that are inside another sentence or another question.

Here are some questions:

Where is Maria?
What is Bill doing?
Why is Sheila late?
When is the meeting?

When these questions are inside another sentence, you change them:

6. What time is the movie?

I don't know where Maria is.
I don't know what Bill is doing.
I don't know why Sheila is late.
I don't know when the meeting is.

(Because you are not asking the question, you have to change the order of the words.)
