

### 4.1 Introduction to Future Tense



We use the **future tense** to talk about things that *will happen after now*.

**Future tense is easy!** To use the future tense, you say **will** before the verb.

**\*To make a negative future tense sentence, you say "will not" (or "won't") before the verb.**

<b>I</b>	<b>will won't</b>	play baseball	tomorrow.
<b>He / She / It</b>		go to Spain	tonight.
<b>You / We / They</b>		play any games	next week.
		give me money	next month.
		brush his teeth	next year.
		be in school	in 2 days.
		be hot	in 2 weeks.
