

4.12 Future Tense / Present Continuous Tense



We sometimes use the **present continuous tense** to talk about our future plans.

I will go to Japan tomorrow.

→ I am going to Japan tomorrow.

→ I am going to go to Japan tomorrow.

I will eat at a restaurant tonight.

→ I am eating at a restaurant tonight.

→ I am going to eat at a restaurant tonight.
