

## 4.8 Future Tense: "going to"

We use the future tense to talk about things that **will happen** after now. There are many ways to talk about the future:

- You can use will + verb (or won't + verb):
  - I will go to the supermarket tomorrow.
  - Jackie won't play soccer because she is sick.
- You can also use **be verb + going to + verb:** o I am going to walk to the supermarket tomorrow.
  - Jackie is not going to play soccer because she is sick.
- eat pizza tonight. am go to Mexico next year. help me with my homework. going to He / She / It is rain tomorrow. not going to be tired tonight. run in the race next week. You / We / They are cook dinner tonight.
