We often use **be verb + going to + verb** to talk about the future:

I	am	going to not going to	see a movie on Saturday.
He / She / It	is		come with me.
You / We / They	are		get a part-time job.
			be hot this summer.
			go to the beach on Sunday.
			be tired if you go running.
			review our homework tonight.
