

To use the <b>passive voice</b> , you say: <b>Object + [Be Verb + Past Participle] + by + Subject</b>	
Active Voice: A truck hit the stray dog yesterda Passive Voice: The stray dog was hit by a truck Active Voice: A tornado destroyed the house. Passive Voice: The house was destroyed by a to Active Voice: That car hit me. Passive Voice: I was hit by that car.	yesterday.
*Remember: the <b>be verbs</b> are <b>am, is, are, was,</b> and <b>were.</b> *The passive voice is usually past tense, so we usually use <b>was</b> or <b>v</b>	ere.
