

## 4.5 Passive Voice: No Subjects



We often use the **Passive Voice** when:

- we don't know what the subject is...
  - The door was opened (by someone I don't know whom).
  - My car was stolen (but I don't know who stole it).
- or the subject is not important, or we don't want to say the subject
  - This paper was written very well.
  - Jordan was given a car for his birthday.
