

3.17 Past Tense: Phrases with Two Verbs

When you have two verbs together in a past tense sentence, the **first verb is past tense** but **the second verb is simple form**.



I forgot to give my dog a bath yesterday.

→ **forgot** is past tense; **give** is simple form

I went out to see a movie last night.

→ **went** is past tense; **see** is simple form
