

3.2 Past Tense: Pronunciation of "-ed"



For past tense, you often add **-ed** to the verb (these are called the **Regular Verbs**).

"-ed" can have 3 different sounds: **t**, **d**, or **ed**.

"t"	"d"	"d"	"ed"
asked	cleaned	played	needed
looked	learned	used	started
finished	listened	studied	counted
talked	changed	closed	wanted
worked	turned on	tried	ended
watched	turned off	opened	handed
