

2.1 Introduction to Present Continuous Tense



We use the **present continuous tense** to talk about things that are happening **right now**.

To talk about **right now**, you have to use a **be verb** (am, is, are) and a **verb+ing**:

I	am	going	to the city.
		reading	books.
He / She / It	is	playing	baseball.
		talking	too loudly.
You / We / They	are	watching	a movie.
		jumping	and singing.
		walking	slowly.
