

## 2.3 Present Continuous Tense: "-ing" Rules

When you add -ing to a verb, you have to be careful!

\*If the verb ends in a **short vowel and a consonant** (**hit, run, set, get**), you have to **double the last consonant**, then add -ing.

- Wrong: hiting (x)
- Right hitting

\*If the verb ends in **consonant+e** (**share, make, write**), you **don't write the e** when you add -ing.

- Wrong: makeing (x)
- Right: making
