

2.6 Present Perfect Tense: Already & Not Yet

We often use the **present perfect tense** with "already" or "not yet."



I have already eaten dinner.
I haven't eaten dinner yet.
She has already taken the English test.
She hasn't taken the English test yet.
It has already stopped raining.
It hasn't stopped raining yet.
