

2.7 Present Perfect Tense: For & Since

We also use the **present perfect tense** with the words **for** and **since**. We often use **"haven't"** or **"hasn't"** to talk about the last time that something happened.



The last time I went on vacation was in 2023.

→ **I haven't gone on vacation since 2023.**

The last time I slept in was a long time ago.

→ **I haven't slept in for a long time.**

The last time Jane played golf was before she broke her leg.

→ **Jane hasn't played golf since she broke her leg.**
