


## **1.2 Introduction to Present Tense**

We use the **present tense** to talk about things that always happen, habits, and facts.



Wrong: Jake play tennis every day. (x) **Right: Jake plays tennis every day.**  Wrong: Ana finish her homework after school. (x) **Right:** Ana finishes her homework after school.
