

### 1.3 Present Tense: Change -y to -ies

\*When you add **-s** to a word that ends in **consonant-y** (**cry, fly**), you have to **change the -y to -i and add -es**.

Wrong: flys (x)  
Right: flies

Wrong: crys (x)  
Right: cries

Wrong: frys (x)  
Right: fries

Wrong: emptys (x)  
Right: empties



I empty the trash every night.  
You study English a lot!  
We try a new sport every year.  
They fly in the sky.

He empties the trash every night.  
She studies English a lot!  
It flies in the sky.
