## **5.1 Subjects and Verbs**

The subject of a sentence is the most important noun in the sentence. The subject is what the sentence is about. The subject is usually the first noun in the sentence.

## My car is dirty.

- What is the sentence about? ("My car")
- The **subject** of the sentence is "car" (or "my car").

## I want to go to the USA.

- What is the sentence about? ("I")
- The **subject** of the sentence is "I."
