5.2 Subjects and Verbs

The subject of a sentence is the most important noun in the sentence.

The subject is what the sentence is about.

The **subject** is usually the first noun in the sentence.

Mexico is a big country.

- What is the sentence about? ("Mexico")
- The **subject** of the sentence is "Mexico."

We will visit my family and drive to the mountains.

- What is the sentence about? ("We")
- The **subject** of the sentence is "we."
