

### 5.6 Subjects and Verbs

Usually a **noun** is the subject of a sentence.  
If you have a **verb+ing**, it can be the subject of a sentence, too!

**\*If a word ends in e, don't write the e when you add -ing.**

Wrong: Writeing (x)

Right: **Writing**

Wrong: Practiceing (x)

Right: **Practicing**

...is healthy.

**Practicing English**

...helps me get good grades.

**Writing homework**

...is boring.

**Watching TV**

...is not very fun.

**Reading comic books**
