

5.6 Subjects and Verbs

Usually a noun is the subject of a sentence. If you have a verb+ing, it can be the subject of a sentence, too!

*If a word ends in e, don't write the e when you add -ing.

Wrong:	Writeing (x)
Right:	Writing

Wrong: Practiceing (x) **Right: Practicing**
