In the first section of the IELTS speaking test the examiner will ask 3-4 questions about 1 topic. You will normally be asked about 3 different topics.

Tip: Never give one-word answers. Always give a reason for your answer; do not make the examiner ask you, "Why?"

Example: Do you spend a lot of time outdoors?

Answer: Yes, I do go outside a lot because I enjoy taking walks and

breathing fresh air.
